### Program Background

- School Food Service Kitchen Equipment Grant
   Developed for Kane area schools and other childcare institutions.
- Goal
   Help schools obtain equipment needed to meet their food prep, storage, and scratch cooking needs. Build the institutional marketplace for fresh, locally grown foods.



### Background Continued

#### Concept

An extension of farm to school programming developed by the Illinois Farm to School Network and Growing for Kane / Kane County teams.

#### Marketing

The opportunity announcement has been distributed to all school districts in Kane and several neighboring districts serving high need students. Posted to IFSN website and e-newsletter distribution.





## Eligibility

#### Applicants

Must be participants in the National School Lunch Program (includes schools / school districts, early childcare centers, and boarding facilities). Preference for facilities in Kane.

#### Expenses

Eligible equipment expenses limited to food prep and storage activities - must be connected to food service or garden tasting program.



### Grantee Requirements

- Kitchen Equipment Audit
   All grant recipients must complete audits of their kitchen prior to receiving funding.
- Reporting
   Recipients must submit end-of-program report documenting purchase and use of equipment.

No matching contribution requirement



### Award Info & Application Links

#### Award Limits

Individual institutions - eligible for award amounts up to \$1,500 per site. School districts with multiple sites - eligible for award amounts up to \$3,000 serving two or three sites.
